NATIONWIDE

- 32 million adults in the U.S. can't read.
- 21% of adults in the U.S. read **below** a 5th grade level.
- 19% of high school graduates can't read.

14% of U.S. adults can't read.

PRICE OF THE STATUS QUO...

- Nationwide, **85%** of court-involved youth are functionally illiterate.
- **75%** of welfare recipients fail to read.
- Virginia ranks 34th for graduation rates with regular diplomas for students with specific learning disabilities (those who struggle with reading and writing, not intellectual abilities).
- 57% of Virginia's 4th graders are **not** proficient readers.
- Kids who aren't successfully reading at grade level by the **third grade** are 4 times **less likely** to finish high school.


